The new schedule ensures that every student at WES has PE, Computer Lab, and Media Center classes each week, and also has a Life Skills class, Guidance and Art.

The Life Skills class is taught by a certified social worker along with the WES School Resource Officer. The class focuses on conflict resolution, mental health awareness, and other various social-emotional needs.

The Art curriculum has therapeutic aspects built in to teach students overall wellness.

Finally, the schedule includes a 45 minute "Club" block each week where every staff member on campus leads a small group of students in exploration of various topics of interest that the students select. The club options include reading, nature, art, drama, future Bearcats, coding, gardening, and many more.

Teachers "win" with the schedule too, as time has been built in for professional growth opportunities as well as instructional and grade level team meetings during the day with an Instructional Coach. This will help strengthen instruction, align curriculum campus-wide, and protect time after school for teachers to work at their leisure in their classrooms.
