March 4 Information Packet distributed to 8th grade students. ParentLink message sent to 8th grade parent(s)/guardian(s) informing them the 8th grade students were given an information packet outlining the HS Application Process and the information is also posted on Anson County Schools' website www.ansonschools.org.

March 5 8th grade students will meet with Anson High School staff at Anson Middle School during PE class.

June 18-24 The High School Selection Appeals Committee will meet to determine student high school placement based on appeal information.


