## The Hummingbirds are Coming!

Keep your eyes peeled, thousands of hummingbirds are headed right for North Carolina during their migration this spring

Good news, North Carolina! The annual hummingbird migration is nearly underway and we're ready to begin spotting the graceful Ruby-throated Hummingbird in backyards around parts of the Tar Heel State! Make sure your backyard is ready by setting up one of the best hummingbird feeders possible for these oncoming beauties.

Each fall thousands of these exquisite winged creatures migrate south from as far as Canada all the way down to Central America, Mexico, and parts of Florida – until it's time to head north again in the spring to breed.

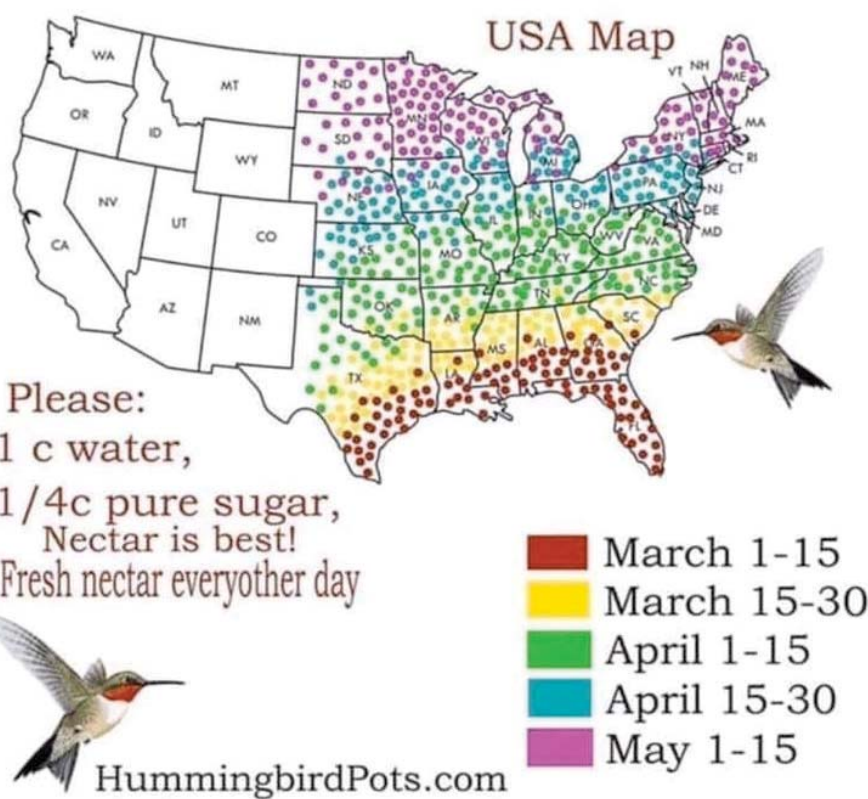
From mid-March through the beginning of April, thousands of them will take flight and land in backyards all over North Carolina to rest and eat as they make the journey.

Hummingbirds are amazingly strong birds despite their small size. Though they're only 2 to 4 inches long, they can fly up to 1,300 miles in one go. Those super-fast wing speeds really come in handy.

In some cultures a hummingbird's visit is believed to bring good luck, joy, and love to the person gifted with spotting them.

The public is invited to help shape the future of the Town of Wadesboro in the development of a Land Use Plan.

The Town of Wadesboro is holding two community input meetings (first round) to gather ideas and thoughts from residents and stakeholders on where and how Wadesboro should grow in the future.

The Town of Wadesboro, with the help of Uwharrie Planners, is working to draft a 2045 Land Use Plan. The Land Use Plan is a critical part of Wadesboro's development, planning, and zoning processes. The Plan, if adopted by the town board and implemented, will require occasional updates to keep up with community changes and needs for the future, and to facilitate growth in a way that keeps Wadesboro a safe and vibrant place to live, work, play, and conduct business.

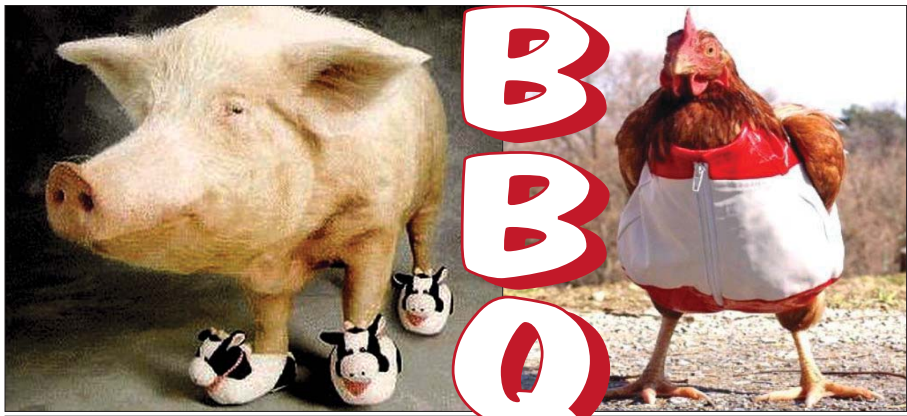
Your attendance at a community input meeting is extremely important. The community input meetings' date, time, and location are below:
