The first Mobile Food Pantry will be held on Wednesday, April 2 at the Bethel UMC Community Building at 11 a.m. The Community Building is located at the corner of Bethel Road and Highway 742 South. Each person should bring their own bags, boxes or carts to carry their food. If you are unable to carry food to your car, you will need to bring someone with you to assist. To ensure safety and reduce confusion issues, any person causing any disturbance such as breaking in line or pushing will be asked to leave the premises. Any profanity or obvious alcohol/drug issues will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave the premises. Also, you will only be allowed to go through the line one time. Any food remaining will be donated to local ministries.
