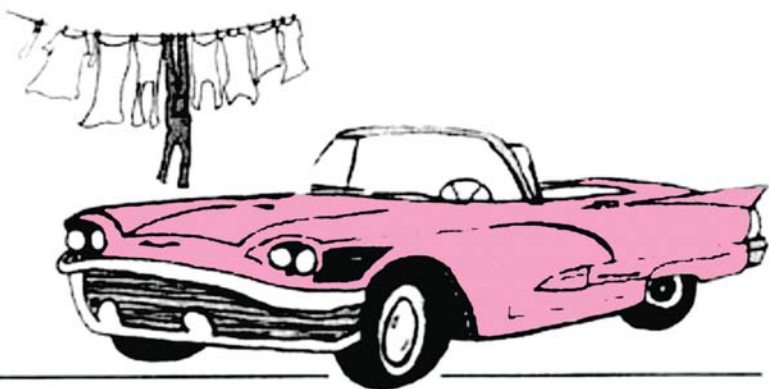

Was looking through some of my "accumulated picture collection" the other day and saw this one of Maner and Murray Grocery - and what memories.

This one goes back a few years to a very special time in history, a time when the "Lady of the House" would go to the telephone and call her grocery order in - especially some of the people who lived "close in to town." One of the grocers was Maner and Murray (and there were several others). Through the many years of my early "sign painting" days I had the pleasure of lettering many trucks for some of these grocery stores...and many others as well.

As I think back I also remember so many other grocery stores - many that are not here today. In fact, there are no grocery stores in the "square block" area. It was in that area that when I finished high school I came to town to work in the A&P Grocery Store - making, I thought, "good money" for a Saturday's pay (less 2¢ for Social Security). I worked from 7:30 a.m. to sometimes 1 or 2 a.m. - or until we cleaned up the store and re-stocked the shelves. There were no Sunday hours, but we would have it ready to open on Monday a.m.

That \$2 pay was really something (less 2¢ of course), and in the "Depression Era" too!
