The Marshville Museum and Cultural Center is located at 201 North Elm Street in Marshville. It is open Fridays and Saturdays, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Sundays, 1 to 4 p.m. Information is available at 704-624-2602.

- The Marshville Museum and Cultural Center welcomes additional docents (trained museum volunteer guides). Docents, working in shifts of four hours or more, typically work in pairs.
