## • PROSTATE CANCER SCREENING

The 5-year relative survival rate for prostate cancer in the United States is 97%.  
The 10-year relative survival rate is 98%.

The survival rates for prostate cancer vary based on the stage and grade of the cancer, a person's age and general health, and how well the treatment plan works.

## • BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENING

Untreated or uncontrolled high blood pressure can result in a heart attack.

## • A1C TESTING

12.8% of NC adults have been diagnosed with diabetes, greatly increasing health risks.

## • HEPATITIS C SCREENING

20% of people with Hepatitis C will develop liver function problems if left untreated.

## • ORAL CANCER SCREENING

The incidence of oral cancer increases with age. The increase becomes more rapid after age 50, particularly for adults aged 65 years and older.
