

Youth Tackle Football 2017

Registration for Anson County Parks & Recreation Youth Tackle Football will continue through the deadline of Friday, July 21. You may register by coming to the Parks & Recreation Offices at Little Park Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. The cost is \$30 per person. A copy of a sports physical and birth certificate are also due by July 21.

- Parks & Recreation will have registration for grades 3 & 4 and 5 & 6. If enough children sign up in these selected grades, Parks & Rec will host its own league. In the event there are only enough for one team, Parks & Rec will abide by the rules listed below.
- A player is eligible to compete in Division I if he/she does not turn 8 years of age on or before November 1, 2016. A player is eligible to compete in Division II if he/she does not turn 10 years of age on or before May 1, 2017. No Exceptions!
- A player is eligible to compete in Division II if he/she turns 10 years of age on or before November 1, 2016. A player is eligible to compete in Division II if he/she does not turn 12 years of age on or before May 1, 2017. No Exceptions!

Program on Forestry Markets and Trends

Did you know Anson County ranks fourth in the state in timber sales? Are you a private forest landowner who has thought about selling timber in the near future but are unfamiliar with timber market trends or how to go about selling a tract of timber? Anson Extension will host two programs to help answer those questions.

The first program, "Timber Markets Explained," took place on Tuesday, June 6 with visiting speaker Dr. Dennis Hazel, Extension Forestry Specialist and Assoc. Professor at NC State University. In July a follow-up program on "How to Sell Your Timber" is scheduled for Monday, July 17, between 5:30 and 7:00 p.m. at Anson Extension, 501 McLaurin Street in Wadesboro. Another visiting speaker, Dr. Mark Megalos, Extension Forestry Specialist, NC State University will explain factors that can influence your timber profit. He will also cover cost of regeneration, important management objectives to consider, and overall forestry financial planning. The program is free, but please register ahead by calling Anson Extension at 704-694-2415 to ensure adequate seating.
