Anson County School Nutrition Department began preparation for the 2024-2025 School year with attendance at the NC Summer Meals Program training in April 2024. **Summer Meals** Anson County School Nutrition is a sponsor for “Non-Congregate Meals” during the summer 2024. By the end of the summer Anson County School Nutrition Department will distribute more than 1,600 Multi-Day meal boxes that will equate to over 8,300 meals served to children between the ages of 1 year old to 18 years old. Tamara Baker with the North Carolina Hunger Initiative delivered educational materials and provided thermal bags that were given to participants in the Non-Congregate Meal Program.

How to register

- You will receive a confirmation via email. Check your Spam folder if you don't receive it.
- Use your email address and password to log in to your account.

How to add children to your account

- Sign in to **SchoolCash Online** at <https://ansonschools.schoolcashionline.com/> or by scanning the QR code above.
- At the top of the page, navigate to **My Account**.
- From the dropdown menu, select **My Students**.
- Click to add a child:
 - Type your school board name.
 - Choose your school from the list.
 - Enter your child's details. You may add up to 8 students to your account.
 - Click **Confirm**.

How to make a payment

- Select the item which you would like to purchase & click **Add to Cart**.
- Once you have finished adding items to your cart, click **Continue** to make a payment.



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ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

When a student misses **2** days a month..

They will miss **20 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **30 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **1 YEAR** of school by graduation.

When a student misses **4** days a month..

They will miss **40 DAYS** a year.

They will miss **60 HOURS** of math over the school year.

They will miss **120 HOURS** of reading & writing over the school year.

They will miss over **2 YEARS** of school by graduation.
