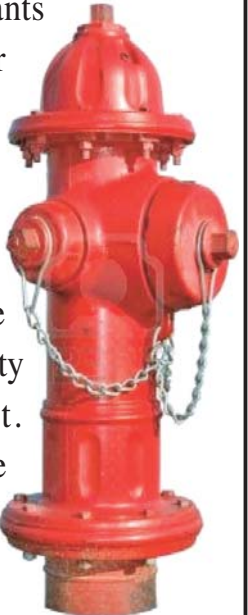
Unauthorized Hydrant Use
