Goshen Mobile Health Unit to Visit Anson County

The Goshen Medical Center Mobile Health Unit have two upcoming visits to Anson County in October and November. Their team will conduct screenings and refer persons to local medical facilities if a need is identified. As Goshen Medical Center is a Federally qualified healthcare organization, no one will be denied access to services due to inability to pay. If assistance is required to meet payment obligations there is a discounted sliding fee schedule available to those who qualify.

The first visit will be on Wednesday, October 16 at the Anson County Health Department, located at 110 Ashe Street in Wadesboro, 9:00 a.m. until 12 noon. The second visit will occur on Thursday, November 14 at the Caraway Center, located at 9162 Highway 52 North in Ansonville, 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

The Mobile Health Unit offers free screenings such as: cardiac screenings (risk evaluation & EKG); depression screenings; tobacco cessation counseling; blood pressure & vital signs check; and sports physicals. In addition, primary care visits & acute visits.
