

Leaf-ing It All Behind: Explore NC's Scenic Byways

Fall is in full swing, and Mother Nature has gone all out with her seasonal wardrobe. Western North Carolina may still be sweeping up after Hurricane Helene, but its scenic byways are open, shining, and ready for your leaf-peeping road trip — pumpkin spice latte optional but highly encouraged.

With recovery efforts underway, it's a great time to hit the road, soak in the golds and reds, and help support local businesses along the way. Sixty-two scenic byways weave through North Carolina, offering everything from mountain views to "did-we-take-a-wrong-turn-or-is-this-a-postcard?" moments.

"North Carolina's scenic byways not only showcase some of the state's most breathtaking fall landscapes but also serve as vital routes supporting the recovery and resilience of communities impacted by recent storms," said Jeremy Goodwin, N.C. Department of Transportation's roadside environmental engineer. "This season, travelers have a wonderful opportunity to explore, enjoy the stunning scenery, and contribute to the ongoing revival of Western North Carolina's towns and local businesses."

So grab your map (or GPS if you're fancy), cue up your best road trip playlist, and prepare for some seriously scenic leaf therapy. These mountain byways are open and ready for adventure:

• Appalachian Medley • Big Horse Creek Byway • Cherohala Skyway • Fontana Byway • Forest Heritage Scenic Byway • French Broad Road • Highlands of the Roan Byway • Historic Flat Rock Byway • Interstate 26 Scenic Byway • Little Parkway • Mission Crossing • Mt. Mitchell Scenic Drive (Mt. Mitchell State Park is open but must be accessed via the Blue Ridge Parkway's western side.) • Nantahala Byway • New River Valley Byway • Upper Yadkin Way • U.S. 421 Scenic Highway • Waterfall Byway • Whitewater Way

Before heading out, check DriveNC.gov to make sure your route is clear — because no one wants their adventure to end in a traffic cone conga line. For more colorful detours and travel inspiration, visit nccdot.gov and see why leaf season in North Carolina is always worth the drive.
