Early Childhood Educators Unite to Advocate for Voting Rights and Quality Childcare

Anson County facilities adjust hours to ensure staff can cast ballots

Early childhood educators across Anson County are proving that civic duty starts with community care. In a joint effort to promote both civic engagement and the value of early education, local early learning centers will adjust their hours on Tuesday, November 4, 2025, to allow employees time to vote.

This coordinated action follows an advocacy workshop hosted by the Anson County Partnership for Children (ACPC) on October 9, led by Dr. Sharon Little. Directors from local childcare facilities gathered to discuss ways to strengthen early childhood programs while ensuring their educators have access to the ballot box.

Soon after, the group attended the Anson County Chamber of Commerce's "Politics After Dark" event on October 14, where they spoke directly with candidates about the challenges facing the childcare sector.

"Our early childhood educators are essential workers who are often overlooked," one participant said. "Empowering them to exercise their civic duty benefits not only them but also the children and families we serve."

The effort underscores the educators' concern about potential federal and state budget cuts that could impact access to affordable, high-quality childcare. As these educators emphasized, local representatives need to understand that investing in early education is investing in the future of Anson County.
