Studebaker's Birthday, etc.

You were supposed to be reading a different "Remembering" column today, but that "April 4th date stood out" - so here we go... I had finished high school at Ansonville in 1939 and had worked enough to know that I could not keep my 1930 A-Model Ford Roadster out of the shop and on the road. So, the new 1941 Studebaker Champion that cousin Henry Spears had really looked good. I traded for this car on April 4, 1941 - "Brand New" - financed at the Bank of New Ansonville) with monthly payments of \$30 that I paid faithfully to Mr. Kimbrough until it was "paid off!!!"

This car was a "sharp - and economical" to operate and in fact, there were several around the county. Some people owned the mid-size Studebaker Commander, and a few, like Allen's grandfather, Dr. Bob Lyon, owned the "Studebaker President." The President was a real luxury car for those days - even if it was before those days - electric door locks, electric windows, backup lights, air conditioning - you name it!! However, some of these cars (for extra money) had the "automatic" bill holder!

You will note in the picture that I had a grill guard, and two fog lamps too. Not much else though, except I did have a heater!!

We should expect some change, however...it has been just 67 years.
